**ACADEMIC WAIVERS AND OTHER SPECIAL REQUESTS, FOR STUDENTS IN THE
COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES, COLLEGE OF BUSINESS, SCHOOL OF
JOURNALISM & SCHOOL OF MARINE AND ATMOSPHERIC SCIENCES**

Requests for exceptions to University curricular and general education requirements (Academic Waivers) are reviewed by the Assistant Provost for Undergraduate Academic Affairs. Students should be aware that as exceptions to University policy and procedure, approvals for such requests are uncommon.

Examples of possible requests include:

Waiver of the foreign language requirement
Waiver of the mathematics requirement
Waiver of a DEC category
Course substitution of a DEC category
Permission to graduate under a pre-existing curriculum

The following requests are virtually never granted:

Waiver of the minimum number of credits to graduate (120)
Waiver of the minimum number of upper division credits (39)

Guidelines for submitting a waiver request:

- Requests must be submitted in writing, either hard copy or by email, using a Stony Brook email address. Please note: A meeting with the Assistant Provost may be scheduled only after she has had the opportunity to review a written statement and documentation.
- Name, ID number, phone number, preferred mailing address and Stony Brook email address must be included.
- Written statements should include reason for request, and any relevant documentation. Support from a faculty member does not assure approval of any request for an exception to University policy, procedure or deadline.
